TRANSPORTATION

Daegu is located at the center of the south east region of the Korean Peninsula. The city is about 300km from Incheon International Airport (ICN) and Seoul. There are three different ways from ICN to Daegu. For detailed traffic information, we will send you a PDF file 1 month before the courses.

1) By Express Bus: There is a direct bus. ICN ⇒ Dong-Daegu directly (4-5 hours)

2) By Express Train [KTX]: There is no direct train. ICN ⇒ Travel to KTX station (60min) ⇒ Dong-Daegu station (100 min)

3) By Airplane

There are direct flights to Daegu from nearby countries such as Japan, China, Thailand, Taiwan and Vietnam.

Also, from ICN to Daegu airport (TAE), there is 1 flight offered by Korean Air every day.

But the flight is available for only transfer from international flight.
